Dear Member Municipal Councils and CAOs,

Thank you for your continued partnership with Saugeen Mobility and Regional Transit (SMART). Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, SMART continues to deliver reliable and safe transportation. While the pandemic has resulted in lower ridership, SMART remains sound financially and is "ready to roll" for increased rides this spring.

Throughout 2021 the SMART Board and management continued to review operations and practices to ensure effective and efficient service delivery. A few highlights from 2021:

- SMART purchased three new 9-passenger buses in 2021 and has three new 9-passenger buses on order for 2022 delivery. These vehicle replacements are fully funded by the federal public transit infrastructure fund and the provincial gas tax program.
- 2. Presentations were made by SMART to the Municipality of Grey Highlands and Town of Blue Mountains. Grey Highlands has since signed on for a trial year and service begins May 1st.
- 3. Effective March 2021, SMART implemented a defined service area and hours of operation:
 - SMART provides service to destinations up to 20 km from SMART member municipal borders, these include: Kincardine, Saugeen Shores, Huron-Kinloss, Arran-Elderslie, Brockton, Hanover, West Grey, Southgate, and Chatsworth and beginning May 1st, Grey Highlands
 - Additionally, SMART provides rides for medical appointments to destinations beyond these boundaries.
 - In response to feedback from our community, SMART extended hours on Friday and Saturday evenings. SMART provides service Monday to Thursday 6:00am to 6:00pm, Friday 6:00am to midnight, and Saturday 7:00am to midnight.
- 4. SMART management and Board members continue to dialogue with Bruce County, Grey County, and Home and Community Support Services staff in an effort to explore partnership possibilities and seamless accessible transportation across all Grey and Bruce communities.

In early May 2022, SMART's auditor sent an electronic copy of the financial statements to all member municipalities. Additionally, please find attached Ridership Statistics Summary January to December 2021.

Lastly, the Board is actively recruiting an Operations Manager. We expect to fill the position soon and we look forward to introducing the new manager to you.
