Recommendation

That council receives the report: Amendment to Landfill Tipping Fees and

That council direct staff include adjusted fees in the Fees and Charges bylaw for a future council meeting

Executive summary

The Infrastructure and Public Works department has reviewed current landfill operating costs and note that the landfills are operating under a deficit. An adjustment to the landfill fees has not kept up to the increased operational costs associated with wages, fuel costs and processing costs. The department must increase the tipping fees to meet the daily operating costs and set aside reserve money for future landfill closure costs.

Background and discussion

A review of adjacent landfill operating costs from Hanover and Grey Highlands confirm that West Grey's landfill tipping fee schedule is not aligned with these neighbouring communities. The department requires the fees be adjusted to support increased operational costs and reduce the impact to the levy.

For example, an operational enhancement of a new mattress and box spring recycling program is being planned. These items would no longer remain in West Grey's landfill site, eliminating the future volumes generated and save landfill space. Our current fees do not cover the cost of such programs.
