Recommendation

That council approves up to \$50,000 for the purchase of half ton 4x4 pickup truck and

That the funds are allocated from the department equipment reserves.

Executive summary

The Infrastructure and Public Works Department has a capital equipment replacement schedule for all equipment. This asset replacement plan provides the department with the scheduled replacement of equipment after its useful life cycle. Failing to follow this plan could lead to increased operating and repair expenses and unreliable use. The purchase of the 4x4 half ton pickup was identified in the asset replacement plan for 2021.

Background and discussion

The department had budgeted to purchase a new half ton 4x4 pickup truck in 2021 and was not purchased due to part shortages created by the global pandemic. The department did not include this item in the 2022 budget as a carryover item from the 2021 budget. The department would like to access the equipment reserve to purchase the truck and stay in line with the asset replacement plan.

The equipment reserve fund includes the 2021 budget allocation of \$40,000. The shortfall from the 2021 pricing to the current market prices can be funded from this reserve which has a
