He reviewed initiatives that are focused on conservation and reduced carbon emissions, as well as renewable natural gas.

Deepikaa Gupta, Grey Bruce Local Immigration Partnership (GBLIP), Coordinator with Sunjeet Kukreja, YMCA - Grey Bruce Settlement and Language Services Program Coordinator and David Morris, Welcoming Community Grey Bruce (WCGB), provided a presentation about the Grey Bruce Local Immigration Partnership.

Ms. Gupta reviewed federal funding, the purpose, composition of the GBLIP and possible partnerships.

Ms. Kukreja reviewed settlement services in Grey and Bruce Counties.

Mr. Morris reviewed the work of WCGB to engage community members and collaborate with organizations and businesses to build a welcoming and inclusive region.
