

The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey

Bylaw No. 75-2022

Being a by-law to provide for the naming of roads within the Municipality of West Grey.

Whereas section 8 of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues; and

Whereas section 48 of the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, as amended, authorizes councils of local municipalities to name or change the name of public highways and private roads within the municipality after giving public notice of its intention to pass the by-law; and

Whereas public notice has been given that council proposes to consider a by-law to name roads in the Broos subdivision;

Now therefore the council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey enacts as follows:

- 1. That the draft plan of subdivision located in the northeast area of Durham, in the Municipality of West Grey, dated May 25, 2021, drawing 01840, shall be identified as Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming an integral part of this bylaw.
- 2. That Street A, as shown on Schedule "A" to this bylaw shall be known as 'Blueberry Lane'.
- 3. That Street A1, as shown on Schedule "A" to this bylaw shall be known as 'Sugar Maple Boulevard'.
- 4. That Street B, as shown Schedule "A" to this bylaw be known as 'Forest Hill Road.
- 5. That Street C, as shown on Schedule "A" to this bylaw shall be known as 'Rustic Oak Street'; and
- 6. That Street D, as shown on Schedule "A" to this bylaw shall be known as 'Elderberry Drive'.
- 7. That this bylaw amendment shall come into effect upon the final passing thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 6th day of September, 2022.
