

The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey Bylaw No. 88-2022

Being a bylaw for setting the rate of speed of motor vehicles from a statutory speed limit;

Whereas the Highway Traffic Act, 1990, as amended, section 128(1) provides statutory rates of speed for motor vehicles on highways; and

Whereas the Highway Traffic Act, 1990, as amended, section 128(2) provides that the council of a municipality may, for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction, by by-law prescribe a rate of speed different from the rate set out in subsection (1) that is not greater than 100 kilometres per hour and may prescribe different rates of speed for different times of day; and

1) for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction; and

Whereas the Council of the Municipality of West Grey deems it appropriate that the speed of motor vehicles on certain highways in the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey be restricted;

Now therefore the council of the corporation of the municipality of west grey enacts as follows:

1. That West Grey Bylaw No. 71-2013 is amended by adding the following provision to Section 2 of the bylaw:

(p) Sideroad 5 from Concession 6 NDR to a point 600 m north on Sideroad 5 (Bentinck).

2. That this bylaw shall come into full force and effect on the date of passing.

Read a first, second and third and final time this 1st day of November 2022.
