

## The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey Bylaw No. 2023-013

A bylaw to amend the Municipality of West Grey Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw No. 37-2006, as amended.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of Section 34 and 36(1) of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990*, as amended, bylaws may be amended by councils of municipalities; and

WHEREAS the council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey deems it expedient and in the public interest to amend bylaw No. 37-2006, as amended, being the Municipality of West Grey Comprehensive Zoning Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey pursuant hereby enacts as follows:

- That bylaw No. 37-2006 is hereby amended by changing the zone symbol on part of lots 4, 5, 6, concession 1, registered plan 155, parts 5 and 6 in the geographic township of Normanby (roll number 4205.010.0050.2500.0000) from R1A (unserviced residential) to R1A (unserviced residential) and R1A-450 (unserviced residential with exception in accordance with Schedule 'A' attached to this bylaw.
- 2. That Section 35.1 is hereby amended by revising the following paragraph: R1A-450 (see Schedule 'A')
  - a. Notwithstanding subsection 11 of bylaw 37-2006 to the contrary, the following provisions shall apply to lands zoned R1A-450 (unserviced residential with exception) as shown on schedule 'A' attached to this bylaw:
    - i. A recreational powersports repair shop is a permitted use;
    - ii. For the purposes of this bylaw a recreational powersports repair shop is defined as follows:

Means a lot, building or structure where services and repairs are provided, which are essential to the operation of recreational powersports but does not include a retail store, automotive body repair shop, automotive sales establishment nor an automotive washing establishment.

- iii. For the purposes of this bylaw powersports is generally defined as vehicles such as motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles (ATV's), snowmobiles, personal water craft and scooters.
- 3. That a total of one (1) parking spaces shall be provided.
- 4. That two (2) employees residing in the residence are permitted.
- 5. That powersports repair shop shall be limited in operation from Tuesday to Saturday.
- 6. That the powersports repair shop shall be permitted to operate on a seasonal basis from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> each calendar year.
- 7. That hours of operation for the powersports retail shop shall be 9:00am to 5:00pm, Tuesday through Saturday.
- 8. That the lands be subject to site plan control.

- 9. That Schedule 'A' and all other notations thereon are hereby declared to form part of this bylaw.
- 10. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon date of final passing.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 7<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2023.
