Landfill Tipping Fess – Bentick & Durham			
Bag Tags	\$2.00 per bag	\$2.50 per bag	Cost of supplies has increased, increase to collection costs, Capital infusion is required at the landfills (weigh scale software) and the need for a Master Plan for long term Waste Management & Diversion. Neighbouring Municipalities, who use bag tags, have raised their fees to \$2.50 per tag with 1 increasing their fee to \$4.00 per bag.
Large brush, 4” diameter or greater	\$10.00 Per 1,000 kg (minimum \$10.00 charge)	-	Fee broken out to reflect clean and contaminated wood.
Large brush, 4” diameter or greater - Contaminated	-	\$10.00 Per 1,000 kg (minimum \$10.00 charge)	
Large brush, 4” diameter or greater - Clean	-	No charge	The original intent was to recoup the cost of handling contaminated wood/brush material. This clean material can be ground into cover, although there is a charge for grinding, feedback from the community is that it has been a deterrent to bring clean wood and brush to the landfill when there is a fee. The landfill requires the clean material for cover and it (clean wood/brush) is a beneficial use for landfill operation.
