



**The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey  
Bylaw No. 2023-062**

A bylaw to amend Refreshment Vehicle Licencing Bylaw No. 38-2020 respecting the addition of clause to require fire inspections prior to being issued a refreshment vehicle licence.

WHEREAS section 11(2) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, as amended, (the “Act”) provides that municipalities may pass bylaws for the purpose of ensuring economic, social well-being of the municipality, and the health, safety and well-being of people in the municipality; and

WHEREAS 151 of the Act provides for a system of business licences for any business wholly or partially carried on within the municipality and allows a municipality to prohibit the carrying on or engaging in the business without a licence, to refuse to grant a licence, to revoke or suspend a licence or to impose special conditions for a licence; and

WHEREAS on May 19, 2020, council passed Refreshment Vehicle Licencing Bylaw No. 38-2020 to licence, regulate, and govern refreshment vehicles in the Municipality of West Grey; and

WHEREAS council deems it necessary and in the public interest to require operators of refreshment vehicles to obtain a fire inspection to ensure that the refreshment vehicle is in compliance with the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act* and the Ontario Fire Code;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey hereby enacts as follows:

1. That subsection 10 of Refreshment Vehicle Licencing Bylaw No. 38-2020 is hereby amended to add the following clause:

A certificate/letter from the West Grey Fire Department noting that the refreshment vehicle is in compliance with the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act* and the Ontario Fire Code.

2. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon date of final passing.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 20<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2023.
