Concession 2 WGR Update

Concession 2 WGR has undergone a transformation this summer as a result of the installation of the Enbridge pipeline. The main pipeline construction is complete, and the remaining surface treated hard top has been pulverized into gravel. Enbridge will return in 2021 to complete any final restoration to the road right-of-way. Plans are being made to replace the hard top surface after the replacement of the Lantz Bridge is complete. There is also a tree planting program that Enbridge will coordinate with the SVCA in 2021.
