**S:** Alicia was walking Jimmy on leash.  
A dog, off leash, came across the road and attacked Jimmy.  
They called into emergency services.  
I called back and spoke to West Grey Officer, Alicia and Tony.  
They elected to be seen on emergency.  
Agreed to pay fees and submit invoice to other dog owner at their discretion.

**O:** Jimmy's Physical Examination

Presented stable, alert, in owner's arms, bleeding pretty much stopped.

Body Condition Score: 7/9      Muscle Condition Score: 3/3  
Microchip #: ~on file      Location of Microchip: scruff

T: 37.5 (normal=100-102.5)  
P: 112 (normal dog=60-160, normal cat=120-240)  
R: panting (normal dog=10-40, normal cat=16-40)

1. Mentation: BAR
2. Eyes: NAF
3. Ears: NAF
4. Teeth/Gums/Mouth: NE closely Periodontal Disease Score: NE/4 (0- perfect, pearly whites--> 4- significant tartar, mobile teeth)
5. Mucous Membranes: pink, moist, CRT <1 sec pink tongue, panting comfortably  
Hydration status: WNL
6. Nervous System: no gross deficits
7. Lymph Nodes: NAF
8. Cardiovascular Auscultation: regular rhythm, no murmur Pulses: Strong and synchronous
9. Respiratory auscultation: Lungs clear bilaterally, no crackles or wheezes

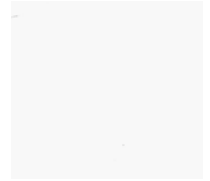
**10. Integument:**

**2 puncture wounds into skin on back**  
**1 puncture wound and 1 deeper impression on left side, ventral chest**  
**no emphysema apparent**  
**suspect some deeper damage to SQ with small bits of fat coming out punctures**  
**do not suspect any broken bones**  
**heart and lung sounds good**  
**bruising starting**

11. Abdo palpation: Comfortable; No pain or masses evident      Rectal exam: NE
12. Musculoskeletal: NAF, no lameness
13. Urogenital: NAF
- 14. Pain Score: 7/10, Acute or Chronic?** (0- jumping, tail wag, absolutely no pain--> 10- passing a kidney stone, vocalizing)  
NAF= No Abnormal Findings



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**A:** Dog bite - punctures

**P:** Language barrier with Alicia  
Hearing barrier with Tony

Had Tony in clinic.  
Did very best to explain everything.

Covered punctures with lube, shaved 1 inch around all punctures.  
Cleansed with hibitaine  
Cleaned away small BM at rectum.  
Bleeding stopped, some fat damage.  
Flushed punctures with bridine.

Elected to leave open to drain, warned of complications with undermining and emphysema (air under skin).  
Stable otherwise.

Bandaged.

Rx 0.46ml Convenia SQ (hard to give pills to)  
Rx 0.16ml Metacam

Rx Syringes Metacam sent home - see script

Set up for recheck tomorrow.
