

The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey Bylaw No. 23 - 2021

Being a bylaw to authorize a Source Protection Plan – Part IV Enforcement Transfer Agreement with Grey Sauble Conservation Authority;

Whereas section 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by bylaw unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

Whereas the Municipality of West Grey deems it necessary to enter into an agreement pursuant to the Clean Water Act, 2006, for the purpose of appointing the Sauble Conservation Authority as agent of the municipality with respect to the enforcement and jurisdictional rights under Part IV of the Act as part of the implementation of the Saugeen, Grey Sauble, Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Plan; and

Whereas the Authority is a Source Protection Authority for purposes of the Act; and

Whereas the Municipality of West Grey is located within the Saugeen, Grey Sauble, Northern Bruce Peninsula Source Protection Region as set out in Ontario Regulation 284/07;

Now therefore be it resolved that:

- 1. The agreement identified as Schedule "A", attached hereto, forms an integral part of this bylaw.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the Municipality of West Grey.
- 3. This bylaw shall be in force and effect upon final passage thereof.
