

## The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey Bylaw No. 26 - 2021

Being a bylaw to authorize a Shared Services Agreement between the Municipality of West Grey and Elephant Thoughts for the provision of a Summer Camp Program

Whereas section 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by bylaw unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

Whereas section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2011, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

Whereas section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides a lower-tier municipality and an upper-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public, subject to the rules set out in subsection (4); and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey deems it necessary and desirable for the public to enter into an agreement with Elephant Thoughts to provide a safe, qualified, effective and efficient Summer Camp Program for the recreation services department of the Municipality of West Grey;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and CAO are hereby authorized to sign a Shared Services Agreement between the Municipality of West Grey and Elephant Thoughts, identified as Schedule "A", attached hereto and forming an integral part of this bylaw.
- 2. That this bylaw shall be deemed to come into full force and effect on the date of its passing thereof.
