Executive summary

The Municipality of West Grey has participated in the Household Hazardous Waste Days (HHW), held at the city of Owen Sound’s public works yard. The HHW is held eight times per year from April to October. The attached agreement and supporting documentation is included for council’s consideration to continue participating in this program.

Background and discussion

The City of Owen Sound is continuing to offer the use of their Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Program to all municipalities in Grey County on a fee-for-use service basis. Participating in this program provides residents of West Grey the opportunity to dispose of HHW in a safe and environmentally responsible manner. The attached document summarizes the materials that were collected and West Grey’s contribution to the HHW Day in comparison to other municipalities in Grey County.
