



**The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey  
Bylaw No. 48 - 2021**

Being a bylaw to authorize a Transfer Payment Agreement between The Municipality of West Grey and The Municipality of Grey Highlands for maintenance of a boundary road;

Whereas section 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by bylaw unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

Whereas The Municipality of West Grey and The Municipality of Grey Highlands are parties to a Boundary Road Agreement wherein both parties share equally the responsibility for the maintenance of the boundary road known as Artemesia-Glenelg Townline; and

Whereas The Municipality of Grey Highlands has agreed to taking responsibility for tendering and overseeing the asphalt repaving project for a portion of the Artemesia-Glenelg Townline, from West Back Line to Pinewood Drive;

Whereas The Municipality of Grey Highlands has proposed funding this project fully in 2021, with repayment from The Municipality of West Grey for their portion of the project in 2022 and 2023; and

Whereas The Municipality of West Grey deems it necessary to proceed with partnering with the Municipality of Grey Highlands to complete asphalt repaving of a portion of the Artemesia-Glenelg Townline, from West Back Line to Pinewood Drive in 2021; and

Whereas The Municipality of West Grey deems it expedient enter into a transfer payment agreement with The Municipality of Grey Highlands to effectively fund asphalt repaving of a portion of the Artemesia-Glenelg Townline from West Back Line to Pinewood Drive in 2021;

Now therefore be it resolved that:

1. The transfer payment agreement attached hereto and identified as Schedule A shall form an integral part of this bylaw.
2. The Clerk and the Mayor are hereby authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of The Municipality of West Grey.
3. This bylaw shall be in force and effect upon final passage thereof.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2021.
