Recommendation

That council approve the tender award to the Murray Group Limited in the amount of \$619,056.05 for paving of Concession 2 WGR and;

That council approve that a guardrail system be installed on Concession 2 WGR, at the “S” bend with the remaining funds from the Enbridge paving budget.

Executive summary

As per the Owen Sound Reinforcement Pipeline Project franchise agreement between Enbridge and the Municipality of West Grey, Enbridge is funding the restoration of the hard top surface of Concession 2 WGR from Grey Rd 4, north to 15th Sideroad WGR (5.5 km). The total project cost is estimated at \$698,848.85.

Background and discussion

There is a franchise agreement between Enbridge and the Municipality of West Grey for the Owen Sound Reinforcement Pipeline Project. Section 8 of the agreement states:

The Gas Company shall well and sufficiently restore, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Engineer/Road Superintendent, all highways, municipal works or improvements which it may excavate or interfere with in the course of laying, constructing, repairing or removing its gas system, and shall make good any settling or subsidence thereafter caused by such excavation or interference.

Enbridge is exceeding their obligation under Section 8 by funding the paving project to restore the hard top surface with asphalt. The previous hard top surface was surface treatment. In addition, new guardrails will be installed at the s-bend to address long-standing safety concerns.
