Recommendation

That council award the engineering services for the Garafraxa Street Box Culvert Replacement project to Triton Engineering Services Limited for the sum of \$59,000 (excluding HST).

Executive summary

The Municipality of West Grey has been successful in acquiring funding for the Garafraxa Street Box Culvert Replacement. The milestone one payment, award of first contract and supporting resolution from council, are required as per the Connecting Link funding agreement.

As the first housekeeping item for the project, an engineer needs to be appointed for the engineering, contract administration, and site inspection as required in Milestone 1 of the Milestone Payment Schedule.
