1. Call to order

Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

4. Presentation

4.1 Lantz Bridge - Engineer's Update

Ken Logtenberg, P. Eng, from BM Ross provided a presentation summarizing the Lantz Bridge Concession 2 WGR tender results.

Two completed tenders were received with bids above the probable cost estimate of \$1,450,000.

Mr. Logtenberg provided the following possible reasons for the cost increases:

- Material price increases
- Contractor availability
- Labour availability and price increases
- Conflicts with hydro lines
- Dewatering more difficult than anticipated
- Tight timeline prior to winter

Mr. Logtenberg also provided council the following options for possible decisions regarding the project, including the pros and cons:

- Option #1 cancel project
- Option #2 Reject tender and re-tender project in January
- Option #3 Accept tender as submitted
- Option #4 Accept tender with revisions

Mr. Logtenberg recommended Option #4 with construction of the bridge to take place in 2021 and the paving of the bridge and guiderail work removed from the tender, for a revised tender amount of \$1,797,604.15 plus applicable taxes.

Mayor Robinson thanked Mr. Logtenberg for his presentation.

5.1 Lantz Bridge Replacement Tender Award

Director Czerwinski noted that the report summarizes the funding for the project.
