Title:	Traffic Study for Saddler Street East

Recommendation

That council consider, during the 2022 budget process, allocating \$10,000 for a consultant firm to complete a traffic study for Saddler Street East, and further

That council consider, during the 2022 budget process, allocating \$7,500 for the development of a traffic calming plan.

Executive summary

The Traffic Safety Working Group recommended to council that a traffic study be conducted for Saddler Street East. Traffic studies assess vehicle activity, speeds, safety, etc. with a goal of identifying potential improvements or mitigation measures, if required.

Background and discussion

Resolution 133-2021 states: "THAT council supports the resolution wherein the West Grey Traffic Safety Working Group recommends that council authorize staff to initiate a study to run a pilot project for speed cushions or similar traffic control measures on Saddler Street East in the Town of Durham to address speed concerns."

An estimate of \$10,000 to conduct a neighborhood traffic study was received from an engineering firm that specializes in traffic solutions. The traffic study consists of providing digital mapping, traffic counts, field visits, data analysis, a plan for countermeasures for consideration, and a report to council. For an additional \$7,500, the firm could prepare a traffic calming policy that would include an implementation process, screening criteria and measures to address identified traffic calming issues.
