1. Call to Order

Mayor Robinson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

4. Delegations/Presentations

4.1 Presentation: Meeting to Consider Engineer's Report for Wright
Municipal Drain 2021, Bill Dietrich, P. Eng., Dietrich Engineering Limited

Bill Dietrich, P. Eng., Dietrich Engineering Limited presented the Wright Municipal Drain 2021 report dated June 13, 2021, indicating the purpose of the meeting to consider is to review the scope of the work being planned for this project. He outlined the municipal drain petition process prior to presenting the final design in the report.

Mr. Dietrich responded to comments and questions from council and the public, clarifying the process and timeline of the project.

Mr. Dietrich confirmed the municipality will not incur any costs related to the construction of the municipal drain.

Deputy Mayor Hutchinson thanked Mr. Dietrich for his presentation. He advised that landowners have an opportunity to remove their name from or add their name to the petition at this time. There were no requests to add or remove a name from the petition.
