Notice of Public Meeting – Development Charges County of Grey

Take notice that Grey County Council is holding a public meeting on October 28, 2021 at 3:00 PM to discuss proposed development charge rates and policies that will be applied throughout the County. Council will be considering the approval of an updated development charges by-law(s) on a date following this public meeting.

Development charges are fees on new developments that fund growth-related costs to a municipality. They are used across parts of Ontario and are governed by the *Development Charges Act, 1997*. County capital services include Land Ambulance, Social Housing, Children's Services, Provincial Offences, Parks Services – Trails, Public Health Unit, Long-Term Care, Development-Related Studies and Services Related to A Highway (Public Works and Roads & Related).

The public meeting is an opportunity for the public to review and provide comments on the 2021 Grey County Development Charges Background Study and the proposed Development Charges Bylaw(s), as required under *The Development Charges Act, 1997*.
