



The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey

By-law Number 59 - 2020

Being a by-law to authorize entering into a Connecting Links Program Contribution agreement with Her Majesty The Queen In Right Of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation for the rehabilitation of Garafraxa Street Bridge.

Whereas section 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by bylaw unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and

Whereas the Government of Ontario has created the Connecting Links Program to provide funding to help municipalities construct and repair roads and bridges on designated Connecting Links; and

Whereas the Garafraxa Street bridge within the community of Durham is a portion of a highway under the control of the Municipality of West Grey and has been designated as a Connecting Link or as an extension to the Connecting Link by the Minister of Transportation in accordance with the Public Transportation and highway Improvement Act, 1990, as amended; and

Whereas the Municipality of West Grey has applied to the Connecting Links Program for funding to assist West Grey in carrying out the Garafraxa Street bridge rehabilitation project and Ontario wishes to provide funding for the project; and

Whereas the council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey deems it desirable to enter into a Connecting Links Program Contribution agreement with Her Majesty The Queen In Right Of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation to receive funding for the rehabilitation of Garafraxa Street Bridge;

Now therefore be it resolved that the council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement with Her Majesty The Queen In Right Of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Transportation, for the Connecting Links Program Contribution, identified as Schedule "A" and attached hereto.
2. That Schedule "A" shall form an integral part of this bylaw.
3. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date of final passing.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 1st day of September, 2020.
