Justification:

Background

In 2020, West Grey completed a compensation and organizational review. That review identified several staffing gaps based on staffing levels and structures of comparable municipalities, current workloads, and council priorities. The consultant recommended four new positions in 2021 and four new positions in 2022. Council, in the 2021 budget, did not approve any new positions for West Grey, other than a full-time position for West Grey Library.

Environmental matters are a high priority for West Grey council: West Grey council declared a climate emergency, formed a new committee, the Climate Action Advisory Committee, with a mandate to provide advice regarding the climate crisis and environmental opportunities for council's consideration, and allocated \$50,000 from the provincial modernization grant to develop a West Grey Climate Action Plan (CAP). Further, council approved West Grey's membership and participation in the FCM Partners for Climate Protection program.

A small staff team including the CAO, the director of public works and infrastructure, the director of finance and the officer, corporate and community initiatives, has been working with ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability on the development of the CAP. On the completion of the CAP, the corporation must be committed to implementing the recommendations and action items. This position will ensure compliance with the CAP.

Regarding capital projects, this position will work in partnership with department heads, supervisors and stakeholders (Grey County, Province of Ontario, etc.) to establish capital projects with a climate action lens.

Consequences of not funding:

Council places a high priority on environmental initiatives and is committed to creating and following a West Grey Climate Action Plan. Without a staff responsible for implementing the CAP, the plan is at risk of failure.

Additionally, the West Grey Vision Plan identifies several environmental priorities that are simply unable to be implemented without adequate resourcing.
