

## The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey Bylaw No. 49-2022

Being a bylaw to assume certain sections of land into the Municipality of West Grey roads system.

Whereas section 26 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, provides that all highways established by a by-law of a municipality on or after January 1, 2003 are highways unless closed; and

Whereas section 31 (2) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 Chapter 25 provides that after January 1, 2003, land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law establishing the highway; and

Whereas the West Grey Director of Infrastructure and Public Works has confirmed that the works have been completed in general conformance with the approved plans and specifications for MacDonald Crescent; and

Whereas WSP Engineering has confirmed that there are no outstanding deficiencies; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey deems it expedient and in the public interest to incorporate certain parcels of lands into the highway road system of the Municipality of West Grey;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey enacts as follows:

- 1. That the lands identified as Street "A" on Part of Park Lots 5 and 6, North of George Street, Registered Plan 500, Municipality of West Grey, Formerly the Town of Durham, known as MacDonald Crescent in the Municipality of West Grey, are hereby assumed by the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey and established as part of the common and public highways of the Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey.
- 2. That a location map, identified as Schedule "A" and attached hereto, shall form an integral part of this bylaw.
- 3. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon date of final passing.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 17<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2022.
